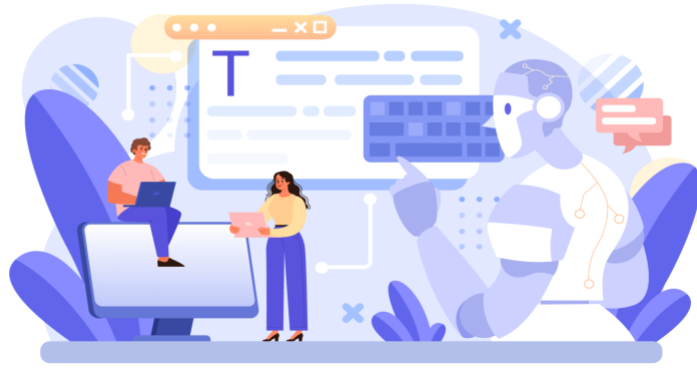

INFINITE: Empowering Higher Education through Artificial Intelligence

The INFINITE project, launched on 1 December 2023 and co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union, is redefining how higher education institutions prepare academics and students for an AI-driven future. By promoting the effective use of Artificial Intelligence in teaching, learning, and assessment, the project helps educators enhance their pedagogical practices and supports students in using AI tools to improve their learning experience. Ultimately, INFINITE contributes to reducing skills mismatches and strengthening Europe's future-ready workforce.

The project focuses on four main objectives:

1. Raising awareness about the opportunities and challenges of AI to foster innovative professional and pedagogical practices in higher education.
2. Developing hands-on resources to help academics integrate AI responsibly into their teaching and assessment.
3. Building digital competences and ethical readiness among academics and students to use AI effectively.
4. Promoting digital transformation within higher education institutions through capacity-building and preparedness.

A Strong Start: Building Foundations for Success

The journey began with the kick-off meeting on 23–24 January 2024 in Nicosia, Cyprus, hosted by CARDET (Center for Advancement of Research & Development in Educational Technology), where partners from across Europe came together to set the foundations for success: aligning visions, discussing work packages, and establishing the collaborative spirit that defines the INFINITE project. Building on this strong start, the consortium now meets monthly to maintain steady progress and ensure the project stays on course — a reflection of INFINITE's commitment to excellence and adaptability in managing Erasmus+ initiatives.

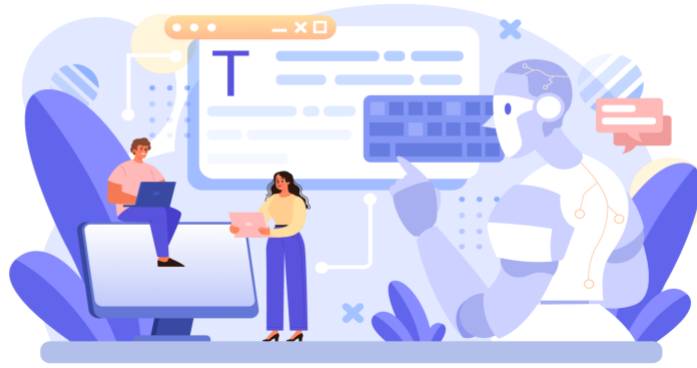
